What is Procurement?

Procurement means the acquisition of works, goods or services

E-Procurement?

The use of information technology in the procurement of goods and services

Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP)

The collaborative use of information and communication technologies in conducting ethical procurement activities, ensuring good governance and value for money in public procurement.



Expectation from the Procurement planning Officers

- prepares the needs assessment and evaluation;
- identifying the goods, works or services required
- Carry out appropriate market and statistical surveys for the purpose of preparing cost estimate
- integrate the procurement expenditure into its yearly budget;
- prescribe procurement method for effecting the procurement.



Benefits of e-GP

- Improved procurement practices for increased transparency and value for money
- Better management of procurement data and records
- Supports social distancing and remote working by reducing amount of physical contacts between government officials and contractors during procurement process
- Reduces time and stress in procurement activities
- Efficiency gains
- Elimination of arithmetic errors in pricing
- Improved and automated bid evaluations
- Easy retrieval of past procurement records
- Structured data base of all contractors, consultants and suppliers registered with the state
- Reduction in procurement cost to Economic Operators
- More convenience procurement process
- ETC.

Different Users Accounts; the account type determines the data accessible to the user

1. Admin account (Osun PPA)
2. Procuring entities account (Ministries, Departments & Agencies)
3. Economic operators (Contractors, Suppliers & Consultants)
4. Civil society, journalists and the general public
